4) VI FORM UPDATE – SAM DANGERFIELD (ADDITIONAL ITEM, NOT ON AGENDA)

- Roll is up on last year, 98 Yr12, 58 Yr13.
- Worked closely with students to ensure they are on the right courses, leading to success.
- Good results will attract more students going forward.
- Trying to address the issue of Level 2 courses not filling the timetable, by looking at other opportunities or possibilities such as a stepping-stone course.
- Mandatory Yr12 supervised study periods have been introduced, with the expectation of a minimum 90% attendance level.
